Principal's Report: (Kathy)

- Was a very busy September
- FNMI Instructor, Crystal Clark, was at the school in September. She visited all classes and did the rock moccasin activity with some of the classes. Elder Glen Waskewitch spoke at the assembly
- Hot spot funding has been provided to help with grade 3, 30+ students in each class. Funding was approved for a 0.6 teacher for language arts and math. Teacher has been interviewed and ready to hire, will start on Tuesday, class of 24 for language arts and math. Will be the larger class size for all other subjects.
- Current class sizes: grade 5: 29 & 30, grade 4: 27 & 27, grade 2: 21 & 21, grade 1 22 & 23.

- Parent concern was expressed about grade 5 class sizes and the fact that these students missed out on learning loss grant and are now in a large class size. Current situation is being pushed onto classroom teacher. The division should be putting the message out there that there is not the money to fund the school system properly. Concern about dragging heals about closing schools to reallocate money to address needs. Information session required. Parent voice needs to be heard, public awareness of the issues, expressed as a concern. Heidi to report to the Board that our parent council would like more communication from the board to parents. Response was that needs were assessed across the school division. Different solutions for pulling funding from other areas.
- Continue to practice fire drills, practice until all out of the building in 1 minute
- Before and After School Care Update: Boys & Girls Club is currently being run by Youth HQ. Has been contacted and expressed interest in starting satellite campus for before and after school care. Youth HQ will be in touch with FCSS and United Way to secure some funding, will need information about space. Organization anticipates could start offering program after Christmas, so that by the start of the new school year they will be established. Interest survey in the spring indicated 30 kids would use the service. Organization has a community outreach objective.
