#### PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Our Pre-Kindergarten program is a language rich program that adheres to the philosophy of learning through play. Pre-K is a quality, early learning, play based program focused on readiness, literacy and numeracy skills.

#### Our Program Includes:

- \* Certified teacher
- \* Monday to Thursday mornings, September to June (8:45 12:00 pm)

#### **Program Requirements:**

\* Screening required for speech, language and readiness needs

#### Monthly Program Fees:

\* Fees are posted on SchoolCash the first of each month, and due by the 15th. Program Fees are \$100/month. Students with special learning needs may qualify for a tuition subsidy.

#### Eligibility:

Children must be four (4) years of age by December 31, 2024 to be eligible for Pre-Kindergarten. A copy of your child's birth certificate is required.

#### KINDERGARTEN

Our Kindergarten program offers two programs: full day Monday/Wednesday or Tuesday/Thursday and scheduled Fridays. Programs are available first come, first serve. Please note each class receives the same programming hours.

#### Eligibility:

Children must be five (5) years of age by December 31, 2024 to be eligible for Kindergarten. A copy of your child's birth certificate is required.

#### **BIRTH CERTIFICATES**

All parents/guardians are required to present legal proof of a student's name, citizenship and birth date when a child is registered in school. If a student was born outside of Canada, official documents from that country must be presented. As we are required by Alberta Education to have these documents for all students, you are required to provide them.







### REMINDERS FOR PARENTS

• If your child is absent or will be late for school, please connect with our Safe Arrival Line at 1.855.756.2797 or use <a href="SchoolMessenger">SchoolMessenger</a>, before 9:00 a.m.

- Please remember to sign your child out in the office if they are leaving early. It is very important in case of an emergency that we know where your child is.
- If your child rides the bus, and has been signed out early, please notify your bus driver that they will not be on the bus going home. If the bus driver does not know where your child is, the office receives a call from the Transportation Department.

### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Indicators are placed at the entrances for our students during inclement weather. If there are no indicators on the doors, students are expected to play outside before school and during both recess breaks. *Please dress your children appropriately for all weather conditions*.

**RED** (-25c) Too cold (or wet) to be outside. Students will stay inside in their classrooms.

YELLOW (-19c) Students may come inside and warm up in the entranceway.

GREEN (Normal Day) Students expected to dress for the weather and play outside.

## **VOLUNTEERS - Information Updated!**

Lochearn School loves volunteers and invites you to take an active role in volunteering at our school. Requirements for Criminal Record Checks have changed. Kindly refer to the following information.

### \* CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK NOT REQUIRED:

- Volunteer is only assisting with a single event
- Volunteer will not be working with students out of direct supervision of school staff
- Examples: helping with food preparation during a special event, assisting with prepping materials in the staffroom, attending a field trip for skating (tying skates) always with the large group

### ★ CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK REQUIRED:

- Volunteer is assisting with multiple events, requiring multiple visits in the school
- Examples: assisting with hot lunch program every week/month, doing one on one site words in the hallway every Friday

## \* CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK (Including Vulnerable Sector Query) - Requirement for Grade 5 Ski Trip and Camping Trip

- Volunteer is working with individual or small groups of students on a regular basis without direct supervision
- Examples: coaching a team, attending an overnight trip or trip that is outside of school hours and they are responsible for students

How to apply: You must take two pieces of government issued identification, at least one must be a photo ID, showing you reside in the same community as the RCMP Detachment.

Cover letters are available from the office so there is no cost. *Please be advised there is a waiting period for the completion of this check. If you require further clarification, please contact the office.*
