Information Items:

Accountability Survey Results: The survey included grade 4 and 5 students (119 students), grade 4 parents (16 parents) and teachers (19 teachers). We improved in safe and caring, citizenship and school improvement. We maintained in the program of studies measure and would like this to be improved for the next survey. We will work to communicate how we teach art and drama. Results showed that people were dissatisfied that we do not teach French and that we don't have specialists for drama and art.

School Goals:

- We will implement strategies that enable all students to develop and enhance skills in **literacy and numeracy**, including reading, writing, mathematics, technology, languages and media.
- Looking into these groups for grade 4 and 5,

Daily Literacy Groups: In grades 1, 2 and 3 students go to "daily literacy groups." This is a time when groups of students come together to focus on a skill. It is intended as a quick intervention to support all students. We run it each day for 30 minutes and will continue 5 weeks. We have groups to help students learn specific skills like beginning and ending sounds, short vowels and long vowels and we also have groups to challenge students with reading and writing. We will also continue implementing levelled literacy intervention. This is a small group, intensive intervention designed for students who are not at grade level in reading.

In Numeracy we will continue to focus on number sense, common assessments, and assessment for learning.

Hopes to see math help.

- We will begin implementing digital portfolios. In the past, we have sent home the
 blue portfolio binder at report card time. FreshGrade is a digital portfolio that
 allows for communication of learning in real time. This will help parents stay
 connected with their child's learning and celebrate successes, as well as provide
 support in areas of difficulty. Freshgrade is a new learning tool for most of us, as
 6 teachers piloted it last year and are helping to lead us this year.
- We will continue with inquiry (project based) learning which focuses on engaging, meaningful and deep learning experiences.
- We will continue with developing our "collaborative response model" which is when teachers, administrators and our student services facilitator all meet to discuss supports and interventions for all students.

FreshGrade
