Danielle talked about the Dare to Care Bullying program for all staff and students to participate in. The Dare to Care workshop will be for staff on March 7 and to share costs we will be with Pioneer Staff as well. Danielle is hoping to include another school as it reduces the costs even less. The program for 2 schools is about \$1700 each. If we include a third school it

will be less. Wondering if Friends of Lochearn would like to support it (or even a portion of it). Tabled this to next month.

Dare to Care bullying program to our schools March 7, 2016. This program will give school staff, students, and parents the knowledge and skills to better understand bullying in order to effectively identify it, deal with it, and prevent it. The training would include a day long school staff session and an evening parent session. Additionally, Dare to Care staff will also spend a day at each school working directly with students. It gets everyone speaking the same language, helps students identify bullying situations and make distinctions between bullying and rude &/or mean behaviour, gives everyone a clear understanding of the various roles in a bullying culture, and allows schools to establish effective practices to deal with bullying.
