Approval of Minutes: Kristin motioned to approve the minutes from the meeting on <u>February 7</u>, <u>2023</u>. Mary seconded.

Chairperson's Report: no report

Trustee's Report: (Heidi)

At last board meeting the following were discussed:

- Transportation for the corridor schools was discussed, along with transition planning for new DTHS.
- AB Transportation came and presented about the twinning of highway 11, one twinning option would be within 150 m of the new elementary school. This option is the least likely.
- Locally developed courses
- Reviewed meeting with town of RMH and Clearwater County. Parties meet annually to keep relations positive and find areas where they can help each other.
- Interruption of Learning Grant: 6 week cycle, Cycle 1 ended middle of Feb.
- K-12 school in Breton, announced when the Provincial government did the budget. Town of RMH schools would move up on the Capital Planning List.
- PD learning 4-6 ELA, shift in skills
- Lot where DT is, school torn down and remediated, then the lot will be put up for sale. Remediation was in cost of new school build.
- New school calendar for 2023-2024 school year was approved.

Principal's Report: (Kathy)

- PreK and Kindergarten registration numbers are looking very good, 16 & 20 (respectively). Very good numbers for this time of the year
- Movie night was as a success
- PD Days on February 24 & 27 were focused on new curriculum

- Assurance survey for grade 4 parents, extended to March 17, because of late mail out
- Meeting with Senior Leadership Team, Principal and Vice-Principal presented on what's happening at the school.
- Gr. 5 bottle drive, almost filled the sea can.
- Grade 5 Bake Sale: earned \$799.95
- Contract for bottle recycling: Current contract holders not interested in keeping arrangement going. Grade 5 teachers are considering taking that on. The arrangement allows them to keep 20% of the refund money from the schools Bottle Depot returns if they take the bottles.
- Jordan's Principle: hire 5 new EAs, to support Indigenous students, interviews over the next few days. Support that lasts until Janury 2024. Students would start school year with support in place.
- Kathy being evaluated by the Superintendent, 15 minute interviews. Happens again next year.
- Board coming on Thursday morning, tour of school and meet with students.
- Assembly at 12:15 on March 15.
- Math intervention starting next week
- Sensory session, March 17 with OT & PT
- Nurture Tree very interested in Before & After School Care, working out deals with the Treasurer.
